### **Compliance Status: Partially Compliant**

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the cases of non-compliance listed below:

#### **Content not accessible**

The content listed below is not accessible for the following reason:

a) failure to comply with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004

- Requirement: 9.1.1.1 - Some non-text content presented to the user does not have an equivalent text alternative that serves the same purpose;
- Requirement: 9.1.3.1 - In some cases, information, structure, or relationships conveyed by the presentation of pages cannot be programmatically determined (or are not available via text);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.3 - The visual representation of text and images containing text does not always have the minimum required contrast ratio, except in the cases provided for by the legislation (e.g. logos);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.4 - Some text, except subtitles and images containing text, cannot be scaled up to 200 percent without using assistive technologies and without losing content and functionality;
- Requirement: 9.1.4.10 - Content that does not require two-dimensional representation (such as data tables or maps) does not reflow when the dimension displayed by the user agent changes;

- Requirement: 9.1.4.12 - When changing text spacing with respect to line height, paragraph spacing, letter spacing, or word spacing, some information or content is lost;
- Requirement: 9.1.4.13 - In some cases, when mouse hover or keyboard focus toggles content between visible and hidden, there is no mechanism to remove the additional content without moving the mouse pointer or keyboard focus, the pointer cannot be moved over additional content without it disappearing, or the additional content is not visible until the hover or focus event is removed, the user deletes it, or the user information is no longer valid, subject to certain exceptions;
- Requirement: 9.2.1.1 - Some features cannot be used via the keyboard (or similar input interface);
- Requirement: 9.2.4.3 - On some Web pages that can be navigated sequentially and where the navigation sequence affects their meaning and operation, some objects that might receive focus do not receive it in an order that preserves their meaning and operation;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.4 - The purpose of some links cannot be determined from the link text or from the link text together with adjacent content;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.7 - The focus indicator is not visible on some interactive elements;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.1 - Page markup code does not always conform to its specification or contains errors, or duplicate attributes and IDs;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.2 - In some cases, user interface components (including: form elements, links, and script-generated components...), name, role, states, properties, and values are incorrect or set, or the user and their assistive technologies are not notified when these change;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.3 - In some cases, status messages are not presented to the user so that assistive technologies can interpret them without having to shift focus.
